Shorter Course of SBRT (radiation) Proves Safe, Effective in High-Risk Prostate Cancer



A shorter course of stereotactic body radiotherapy (SBRT) has been shown to be effective in high-risk prostate cancer. The toxicity has been favorable and the cost is competitive. It was studied at UCLA and uses 5 treatments compared to 45 for standard radiotherapy.
