Would you sleep better knowing your likelihood of developing P Ca is 1/25000 because your PSA is less than 1 Nano gram per milliliter? Tonight, we look at a study of 55,432 European men who were followed for 16 years to determine if the quantity of PSA in a first routine draw can predict the likelihood of developing a Gleason 7 or more serious cancer.
