

## Joint Radionuclide Therapy-Immunotherapy Approach Shows Promise in Prostate Cancer



A combination of radionuclide therapy and immunotherapy has proven successful in slowing the progression of prostate cancer and increasing survival time, according to newly published research. This combination was shown effective in a murine (mouse) model of prostate cancer. Radionuclide therapy and immunotherapy used together show great promise as a therapeutic option for prostate cancer patients. Theranostics plus immunotherapy seems to be an

exciting choice for further study. PD-1 checkpoint inhibitors are being studied when combined with the radionuclide PSMA. Clinical trials are currently underway.
